Exclusive Paid-on-Call Opportunity with Pitt Meadows Fire & Rescue Services

Pitt Meadows Fire & Rescue Services has partnered with the JIBC Fire & Safety Division to specifically invite graduates of JIBC's Fire Fighting Technologies Certificate program (NFPA 1001) to apply for a number of Paid on Call (POC) firefighter positions within the department.

As a POC, you will have the opportunity to gain valuable experience and receive hourly pay for all calls of service and required training. Pitt Meadows Fire & Rescue Services is a 24/7 service provider that responds to 650-750 calls each year. Calls can include First Responder medical aid, fire suppression, interface fires, MVA and rescue, and aircraft emergencies in addition to providing public fire safety education. As a member of the department, you will also be part of the local firefighter association and support the community in various fundraising and social events.

The full list of requirements to be a POC in Pitt Meadows is available <u>on the department's</u> <u>website</u>. Minimum requirements to apply include:

- Be permanently living within the City of Pitt Meadows boundary
- Be at least 19 years of age
- Have a valid BC driver's license (abstract required)
- NFPA 1001 Professional Certification (JIBC ProBoard/IFSAC NFPA 1001 certificate)
- Must attend a minimum of 70% of required practices held every Tuesday night (7-10pm)
- Must attend a minimum of 30% of all calls for service in each six month period.
