

## Changes to the JIBC Associate Certificate in Leadership and Conflict Resolution (ALCR) – Course Requirements and Training Days

Due to changes in our Leadership curriculum, **FMGMT100 Leading the Way** and **FMGMT200 Inspiring Teams and Managing Change** are no longer being offered and have been replaced with [LEAD-1100 Leading the Way](#) and [LEAD-1101 Leading Through Relationships](#). With this change the [Associate Certificate in Leadership and Conflict Resolution](#) is now comprised of 12-days of training, instead of 11-days.

For learners who wish to use FMGMT100 and FMGMT200 towards this Associate Certificate Program, you can supplement with CRES-1475 Coached Small Group Clinic to meet the new credit requirement.
