

Changes to the JIBC Associate Certificate in Leadership and Conflict Resolution (ALCR) – Course Requirements and Training Days

Due to changes in our Leadership curriculum, **FMGMT100 Leading the Way** and **FMGMT200 Inspiring Teams and Managing Change** are no longer being offered and have been replaced with <u>LEAD-1100 Leading the Way</u> and <u>LEAD-1101 Leading Through Relationships</u>. With this change the <u>Associate Certificate in Leadership and Conflict Resolution</u> is now comprised of 12days of training, instead of 11-days.

For learners who wish to use FMGMT100 and FMGMT200 towards this Associate Certificate Program, you can supplement with CRES-1475 Coached Small Group Clinic to meet the new credit requirement.
