ASSOCIATE CERTIFICATE IN WORKPLACE CONFLICT



This program is key for anyone wishing to learn more about the process and practice of collaborative conflict resolution within the specific context of workplace conflict.

When you complete this 11- day associate certificate, you will be able to recognize, understand and resolve conflict more effectively, and build more productive relationships with clients and colleagues.

You will first learn the foundations of collaborative conflict resolution with a focus on self awareness in conflict. You will then apply this understanding and knowledge in a problem solving/negotiation setting. More complex situations in group dynamics will then be explored and finally you will apply analytical skills to a variety of conflict intervention approaches in a workplace setting. Your learning will culminate in a written and practical assessment of your learning, skills and abilities.
