Your Suggested Learning Path

1 START HERE:

You will need to start with these required courses, which form the foundation of future courses:
Foundations of Collaborative Conflict Resolution CRES-1100 (3 days)

OR

Foundations of Collaborative Conflict Resolution: Workplace Focus CRES-1101 (3 days)

It is highly recommended the following two courses be taken in the following sequence:

Family Justice Services in BC FAMJ-1000 (3 days) **Online OR** Introduction to Family Justice Services in Canada FAMJ-1001

AND

Family Violence: Impact on Separation and Divorce FAMJ-1002 (3 days) **Online**

About Online Courses:

One-day (7 hours) **Online** courses are completed over two weeks.

Three-day (21 hours) **Online** courses take six to seven weeks to complete.



2 ADDITIONAL REQUIRED COURSES

Online and On Campus (**Face to Face**) courses can be taken concurrently.

It is highly recommended the following 4 **ONLINE** courses be taken in the sequence below:

- Child Support Guidelines FAMJ-1009 (3 days) (Take this course last)
