

The DACSO survey is conducted annually from January to June, with funding from the ministry responsible for post-secondary education and B.C.'s public post-secondary institutions. The eligible cohort for the 2014 DACSO survey are former students from public post-secondary institutions who completed* a diploma, associate degree, or certificate program in the 2012/13 year (July 1, 2012 - June 30, 2013). Please note the DACSO survey does not include apprenticeship, short certificate, baccalaureate, or developmental (Adult Basic Education, English as a Second Language, and Adult Special Education) programs.

*Some post-secondary institutions may also include near completions for some diploma and associate degree programs
