- V969 **Canadian Corrections--An Overview. The Canadian Penitentiary. Conditional Release.** (3 videos, 27, 33, 38 minutes)
This 3-part video is designed to inform judges about the federal corrections system to assist them in sentencing offenders. Pt. 1. explains the role of the courts in correctional decision-making--it emphasizes the importance of providing information to plan correctional programs which balance the needs of individual offenders with the protection of society. Pt. 2. shows what takes place in federal institutions and examines how inmates are affected by terms of incarceration and how judges' actions can influence the way in which an imposed sentence is served.
