Bridget Brownlow

The Justice Institute of British Columbia (JIBC) is pleased to present alumnus Bridget Brownlow with an honorary degree in recognition of her decades of work in conflict management, including assisting the troubled communities of Northern Ireland.

"It is our privilege to honour Bridget Brownlow for her impressive accomplishments over more than 25 years in the fields of conflict resolution and peace education," said JIBC Interim President and CEO Colleen Vaughan.

"Her leadership and efforts in connecting former combatants and their descendants, facilitating insight into the root causes of

social injustice and conflict, have positively influenced thousands of people internationally."

Brownlow is an adjunct professor in the Faculty of Education and teaches part-time in the Departments of Political Science and Irish Studies at Saint Mary's University (SMU) in Halifax, where her previous roles have included serving as conflict resolution advisor for 18 years.

She is also the founder and former senior program coordinator of the Northern Ireland Conflict Resolution Program, an initiative with the Canadian non-profit Peaceful Schools International. The program sent SMU student volunteers to Northern Ireland to promote peace education and conflict management skills to elementary school children through creative workshops. Over 18 years, the program sent close to 500 students to Northern Ireland where they facilitated workshops impacting thousands of children and youth.

Her work has included collaborating with Indigenous representatives from the Cree and Mi'kma'ki First Nations in Alberta and Nova Scotia respectively and drafting an agreement on Indigenous-led alternative dispute resolution processes available to physicians and employees of the Nova Scotia Health Authority.

She received the Presidential Distinguished Service Award for the Irish Abroad from Ireland's President Michael D. Higgins in 2021, the World Peace Tartan Award (2020), the Paul Harris Fellow Award from Rotary International (2021), and the Peace Medal from YMCA of Greater Halifax/Dartmouth (2018). Brownlow earned a Certificate in Conflict Resolution from JIBC in 1994, as well as a Bachelor of Arts from Dalhousie University and a Master of Arts from SMU, both in history.

BOB HULL MEMORIAL AWARD

The Bob Hull Memorial Award recognizes academic achievement by the top graduating student and future law enforcement professional from the Law Enforcement Studies Diploma (LESD) program. The Award was established in memory of Bob Hull, former Deputy Director and Director of JIBC's Police Academy, who passed away in 2006. Hull served in the RCMP for 25 years before retiring as a Staff Sergeant.
