ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1: SAR MEMBER REVIEWS COURSE REQUIREMENTS

SAR member reviews the Course Calendar at www.jibc.ca/sar for pre-requisite information and course requirements. Pre-requisites can be confirmed by consulting JIBC training records at elearn.jibc.ca.

STEP 2: SAR MEMBER RECEIVES TRAINING OFFICER APPROVAL AND REQUIRED INFORMATION

SAR member speaks with their Training Officer (TO) for approval to apply for the course. SAR members will need to provide their email address, JIBC student number, date of birth, and TO's email address on their application.

STEP 3: SAR MEMBER COMPLETES THE APPLICATION FORM

SAR member completes the application at <http://www.jibc.ca/sar> (click "APPLY NOW" button at the top of the page) and informs their Training Officer of their application so they know there is an incoming approval email.

STEP 4: EMAIL APPLICATION CONFIRMATIONS ARE SENT

Automatic email confirmations will be sent to the applicant, the identified Training Officer, and JIBC. Training officers must approve or deny the application by responding to the email within 5 business days of its receipt. Applications that do not receive training officer responses **will** be considered for the course.

STEP 5: JIBC PROCESSES APPLICATIONS

JIBC will confirm the pre-requisites of applicants and work with EMCR to create the final course rosters. Applicants who are missing course pre-requisites will be contacted during this period.

If courses receive more applications than seats, JIBC will contact Training Officers of SAR groups with multiple applicants and request prioritization of applicants.

STEP 6: JIBC EMAILS CONFIRMS COURSE STATUS (ACCEPTED, WAITLISTED, DECLINED)

All applicants will be informed of their status in a course 6-weeks after the application deadline.

JIBC will register, waitlist, or decline applicants based on criteria established with the Joint Training Committee.

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PROVINCIAL TRAINING

Student travel and accommodation costs are covered for provincial courses. More information about arranging travel and accommodations will be included in enrollment confirmation emails.
