### Student Population

- 40,000 full-time and part-time students.
- 588 full-time international students from 25 countries.

### Employment Outcomes

- 92% of graduates find employment in their field.

### Education

- Average class size is 28 students.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

### English Proficiency Requirements

- Grade 12 English: minimum grade of C (or equivalent)
- IELTS (Academic): 6.5 overall, minimum 6.0 in each skill band
- PTE (Academic): 58 overall, minimum skill band score applies
- TOEFL (iBT): 80 overall, minimum 20 in each skill band

### General Admission Requirements

- Certificate, diploma, and bachelor programs: successful completion of high school.
- Post-baccalaureate diploma programs: successful completion of a recognized bachelor's degree.

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Apply online at [jibc.ca/apply](http://jibc.ca/apply) and pay the \$150 application fee.
2. Send your proof of English proficiency, relevant transcripts, and supporting documents to [international@jibc.ca](mailto:international@jibc.ca).
3. Receive the 'Offer of Admission' letter.
4. Pay the commitment deposit of \$5,000.
5. Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance (LOA)' and 'Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)'.
6. Apply for your study permit.

## AREAS OF STUDY

### Law Enforcement & Investigation

JIBC's Law Enforcement & Investigation programs provide hands-on training in investigative techniques, enforcement skills, and Canadian law. You'll study criminal, civil, and administrative law while developing key soft skills such as negotiation and mediation. Our programs are eligible for the Post-Graduation Work Permit, allowing you to gain valuable work experience in Canada after graduation.

### Program Outcome

Graduates of the Law Enforcement Studies program launch successful careers in areas such as litigation support, employee relations, fraud prevention, compliance, and bylaw enforcement. Many work as paralegals, legal assistants, or security professionals. Some international students have gone on to become police officers in Canada, instructors, or practicing associate lawyers after gaining permanent residency. Our programs open the door to diverse opportunities in Canada's legal and public safety fields.
