This transfer agreement includes the following stipulations:

- JIBC learners are eligible to receive credit for a maximum of 4 courses in the VCC Provincial Instructor Diploma Program.
- JIBC learners must complete the following courses at VCC in order to be eligible for graduation from the PIDP:
 - PIDP 3100 Foundations of Adult Education
 - PIDP 3240 Media Enhanced Learning
 - o PIDP 3260 Professional Practice
 - o PIDP 3270 Capstone Project
- VCC Learners can receive credit for PIDP courses should they wish to transfer into the JIBC ID Certificate. They must complete a minimum of 50% of their courses at JIBC, including the INDC190 Instructional Skills Practicum.
