D2088 **Elder Abuse** (DVD 20 minutes)

As our population ages, incidents involving the abuse and neglect of older persons are inevitably on the rise. This program guides front line officers investigating allegations of physical abuse, scams and frauds targeting seniors, abuse of power of attorney and abuse at long term care facilities. Powerful vignettes featuring Oshawa senior actress Joan Hill, training scenarios, and insightful interviews complete this practical, multi-faceted resource. Looks at current issues of abuse and neglect of older adults. - D1475 **Hidden: Elder Abuse in Aboriginal Communities** (DVD, 13 minutes)
This program looks at intergenerational abuse and how it eats away at the fabric of families. It also shows how patterns of abuse can be turned around through restorative justice, the legal system and combinations of the two. It features a dramatized story about an abuse-ridden family intercut with real-life experiences and wisdom from Aboriginal seniors and community professionals. This program provides an overview of elder abuse, including physical, sexual, financial and psychological abuse and neglect.
