

Guidelines for Use of Equipment

(Keep in Laptop Case)

- 1. Use laptop plugged in (very short battery life).
- 2. Laptop will automatically be logged in.
 - a. If the laptop logs off just press the Enter key.
 - b. Instructors: Contact the Admin. Supervisor for your area for the login information.
 - If an instructor or a staff member has a JIBC username and password, they can connect to their JIBC account, but they MUST connect to the network by cable (not wireless).
- Computer automatically connects to JIBC student Wi-Fi when onsite at a JIBC Campus.
- 4. A mouse is provided for your convenience. If you prefer to use the mouse touch pad and it is locked:
 - a. **Double tap** on the top left corner of the **mouse pad** (where there is a very small light)
 - b. You will get a message that the mouse pad has been unlocked.
- 5. **Save** files on a USB Flash Drive. If you save files on the desktop, they will automatically be erased by the system following a power loss, reboot, or shut down. **The laptop** automatically shuts down, locks the user out and reboots at approx. 2:00am.
- 6. When finished using the computer, place ALL components in the case.
- 7. **Return** laptop to a Library Staff member at the Circulation Desk.
 - a. Do not drop it off or leave unattended on the front counter.


