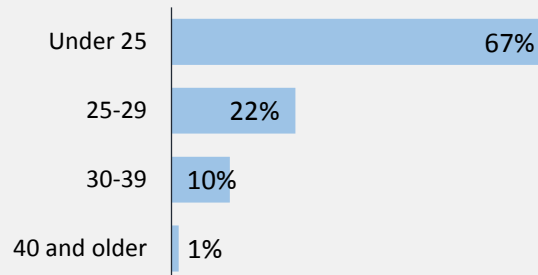

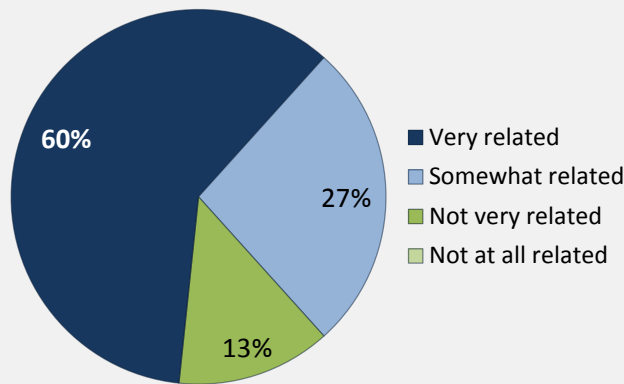

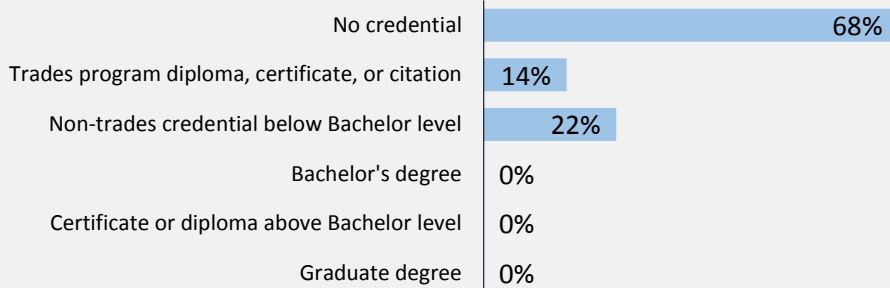

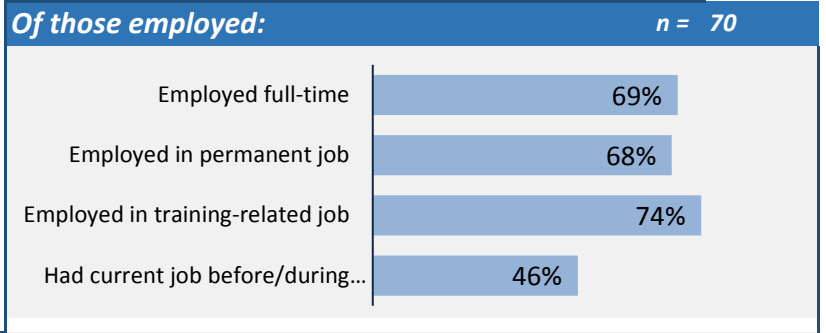

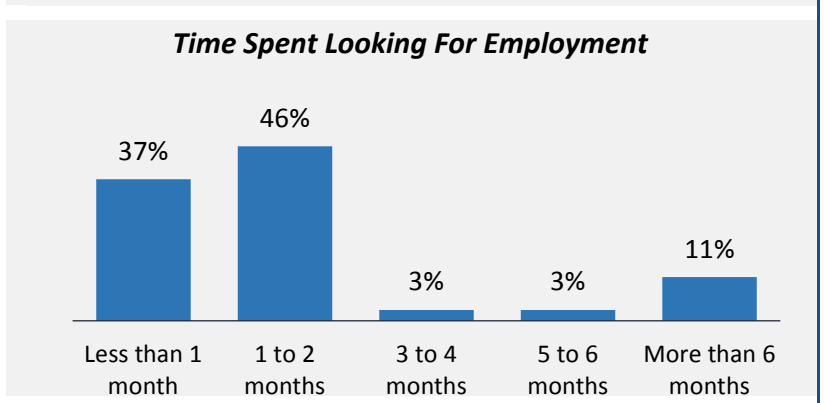

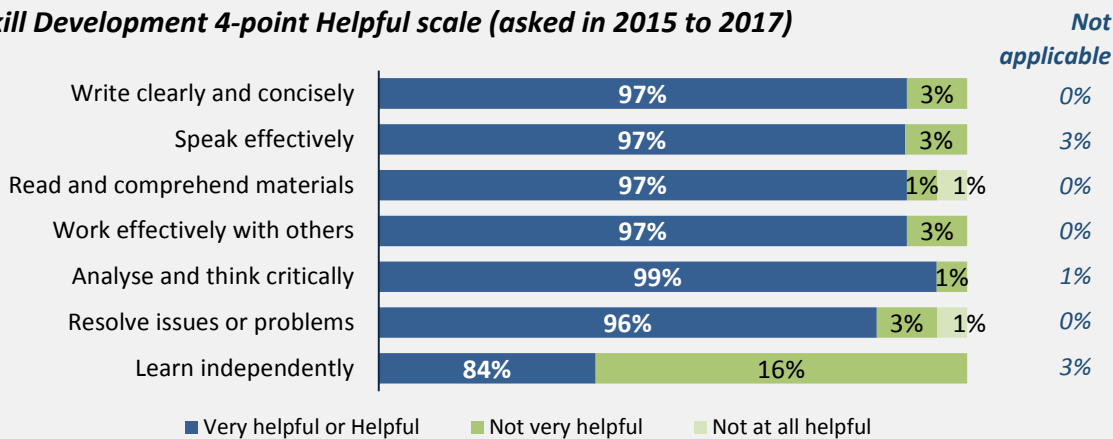

Skill Development 4-point Helpful scale (asked in 2015 to 2017)



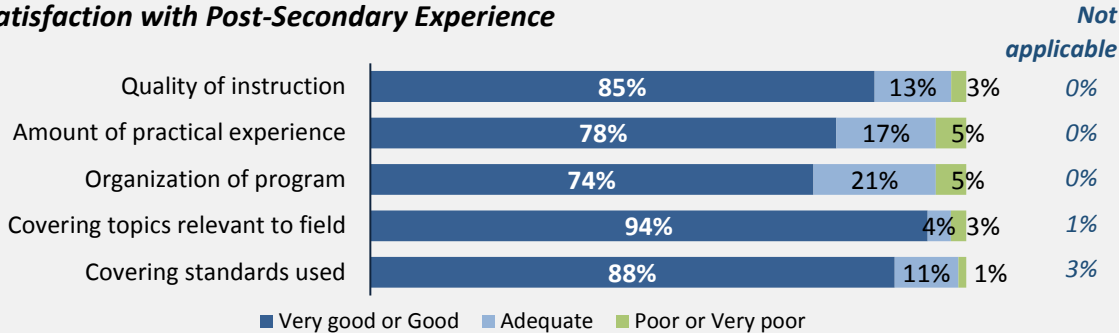
